Theme: Education for Children with Learning Disabilities and Learning Difficulties

According to MEXT (2022), the percentage of students identified as having significant difficulties in learning or behavior is 8.8% in elementary and junior high schools and 2.2% in high schools. Globally, 5% to 30% of students in regular classrooms experience learning difficulties (Farrell, 2023; Westwood, 2013).

The aim of this conference is to share current, research-based information on the education of children with learning disabilities and/or difficulties, with school-teachers, university students, university faculty, and other interested persons.
