e-START Program Application Guidelines (Second Semester, AY 2025)

1. Purpose and Overview

(1) Purpose

The e-START Program is a new type of international collaborative program where Hiroshima University students work together with students from overseas universities on various tasks. The program aims to develop global competencies by using foreign languages and collaborating online with people from different cultural backgrounds.

(2) Overview

The program is mainly conducted during the year—end vacation period (some courses may start earlier). Participants will attend lectures by Hiroshima University faculty and partner university faculty on relevant themes and basic knowledge about the partner country/region. Students will then form groups with overseas students to engage in exchange activities and collaborative tasks, culminating in group presentations.

The e-START Program is offered as a liberal arts course, "Online International Collaborative Seminar (e-START) A" (1 credit).

3. Eligibility

Be able to cooperate with program evaluation and promotional activities after completion of the program.

4. Application Requirements for e-START and START/START+

Participation in e-START course is mandatory for joining START/START+ programs in the second semester. Please check the "Course List" and "Course Details" for requirements.

- After submitting, check "Receive a copy of your responses" and confirm your details. If incorrect, resubmit. The latest submission will be considered valid.

7. Selection and Notification

- Selection will be conducted for each course.
- Methods vary by course and may include document screening and interviews.
- The selection notification will be announced via Momiji or by email within approximately one week after the application deadline for each course. We will contact you through Teams and your Hirodai email address, so please check them daily.

8. Registration and Evaluation

- After selection, the Global Exchange Group will register the course on your behalf.
- •Once course registration is completed, no changes or cancellations to the registered content will be permitted for any reason.
- Evaluation will be based on participation, attitude, group work contribution, presentations, and reports.
- Registration is scheduled for late January 2026.
