

Announcement of an Electric Micromobility Test Ride & Safety Workshop

The Hiroshima University Smart City Co-creation Consortium*¹ will launch Phase 2 of its pilot program starting on April 1 of this year by deploying electric micromobility vehicles at multiple locations, including the Higashi-Hiroshima Campus of Hiroshima University, the Shitami district of Higashihiroshima City, and the area around JR Saijo Station.

Accordingly, in order to promote the safe use of electric micromobility, we will hold a test ride event and a safety workshop as outlined below.
