

海外留学支援制度(協定派遣)による支援について

本別紙は、国際地域課題共修プログラムの参加者のうち、独立行政法人日本学生支援機構(JASSO)による海外留学支援制度(協定派遣)の支給対象となる可能性がある学生向けの案内です。支援制度の対象とならない場合でも、本プログラムへの応募・参加は可能です。

1. 奨学金について

(1) 金額:8万円

(2) 支給要件

- ① 国際地域課題共修プログラムによる留学を行う者
- ② 日本国籍を有する者又は日本への永住が許可されている者(特別永住者を含む)
- ③ 在籍大学等における学業成績が優秀で人物等に優れている者(修士年次 1 学期目の者は学部最終年次の成績評価係数が 2.30 以上であること。)

※成績評価係数の算出方法(修士年次 1 学期目の者は学部最終年次の成績・認定科目は除く)

$$\text{成績評価係数} = \frac{(\text{秀} \cdot \text{優} \times 3) + (\text{良} \times 2) + (\text{可} \times 1) + (\text{不可} \cdot \text{欠席} \times 0)}{\text{総登録単位数(不可} \cdot \text{欠席含む)}}$$

- ④ 本制度以外の派遣プログラム参加のための奨学金等(渡航に係る費用及び返済が必要な貸与型奨学金や学資ローンは含まれない。)を受ける場合、当該奨学金等の支給月額の合計額が、本制度による奨学金月額を超えない者

※注意点

- ・ 本制度以外の奨学金等を受ける際、奨学金等支給団体側が、本制度の奨学金との併給を認めない場合がありますので、予め当該団体に確認してください。
- ・ 日本学生支援機構が実施する「第一種・第二種奨学金」(貸与型)との併給は可能です。
- ・ 日本学生支援機構が実施する「国内の給付奨学金」、「海外留学支援制度(大学院学位取得型)」との併給は認められません。
- ・ 「官民協働海外留学支援制度～トビタテ！留学 JAPAN 新・日本代表プログラム～」との併給は認められません。

2. 渡航支援金について

一定の家計基準を満たす場合、渡航支援金の支給対象となります。

(1) 支援金額:16 万円

(2) 支給要件について

生計維持者全員の収入・所得金額の合計が、以下の基準を満たすこと。

給与所得のみの世帯	年間収入金額(税込)が 300 万円以下
給与所得以外の所得を含む世帯	年間所得金額(必要経費等控除後)200 万円以下

(3) 応募方法

提出書類	市区町村が発行する所得・課税(非課税)証明書(写し可) ※自治体により「所得証明書」「課税証明書」等, 名称が異なる場合があります ※源泉徴収票は不可 ※父母等, 家計を支える方全員分の提出

JASSO Student Exchange Support Program (Scholarship for Study Abroad under Agreement)

This attachment is intended for participants in the International and Regional Challenges Co-Learning Program who may be eligible to receive support under the JASSO Student Exchange Support Program (Scholarship for Study Abroad under Agreement). Applicants who do not qualify for this funding are still welcome to apply for and participate in the program.

1. Scholarship

(1) Award Amount: JPY 80,000

(2) Eligibility Requirements

- ① Students participating in study abroad through the International and Regional Challenges Co-Learning Program
- ② Japanese nationals or permanent residents of Japan (including Special Permanent Residents)
- ③ Students with strong academic performance and good standing at their home university (students in their first semester of master's program must have a grade evaluation coefficient of 2.30 or higher for their final undergraduate year.)

Note: Method for calculating the grade evaluation coefficient (for students in their first semester of a master's program: the grades used are from the final undergraduate year; excluding transfer-credit/recognized courses)

$$\text{Grade coefficient} = \frac{(S/A \times 3) + (B \times 2) + (C \times 1) + (\text{Fail/Absent} \times 0)}{\text{Total registered credits (incl. Fail/Absent)}}$$

- ④ If receiving scholarships or other financial support for participation in a study-abroad program (excluding travel-related expenses and loan-type scholarships or student loans that require repayment), the combined monthly amount of those scholarships must not exceed the monthly amount provided under this program.

Notes:

- Some scholarship-providing organizations may not allow concurrent receipt with this program's scholarship. Please confirm with the organization in advance.
- Concurrent receipt with JASSO "Type 1 and Type 2 Scholarship Loans" (loan-type) is permitted.
- Concurrent receipt with the JASSO "Domestic Scholarship Grants" or the "Overseas Study Support System (Graduate Scholarship for Degree Seeking Students)" is not permitted.
- Concurrent receipt with the "Japan Public-Private Partnership Student Study Abroad Program—TOBITATE! New Young Ambassador Program" is not permitted.

2. Travel Support Grant

Students who meet certain household financial criteria may be eligible for a travel support grant.

(1) Grant Amount: JPY 160,000

(2) Eligibility Requirements

The combined annual income or earnings of all household members who provide financial support must meet the following criteria.

Households with Salary Income Only	Annual gross income of JPY 3,000,000 or less
Households with Non-Salary Income	Annual net income of JPY 2,000,000 or less (after deduction of necessary expenses, etc.)

(3) Application Method

Required Document	<p>Certificate of Income and Taxation (or Tax Exemption) issued by your municipality (a copy is acceptable)</p> <p>Notes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ① The exact name of the certificate may differ by municipality (e.g., “Income Certificate”, “Taxation Certificate”). ② Withholding tax statements (gensen-choshu-hyo) are not accepted. ③ Submit a certificate for each household member who provides financial support (e.g., parents).
