

# Application Guidelines for International Students Needing Meal Card Support

Provided by the Hiroshima University International Student Support Fund

## Purpose of the support

The purpose of this support is to create a better financial environment for international students and to continuously foster and produce global human resources who will be active in the world.

## Support Details

Meal Card Issuance (1-year supply)

## We are accepting applications as follows.

### 1. Eligibility

Applicants must be a self-funded international student and fulfill the following requirements:

- (1) Students who possess the status of residence of "Student" as stated in Attached Chart 1 of Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act (Cabinet Order No. 319 of 1951).
- (2) Students who are enrolled at Hiroshima University, and be in excellent standing in both academic performance and personality.
- (3) Students who have difficulties in completing studies due to financial reasons.
- (4) Students who are not receiving any other scholarships or similar financial benefit at the start of receiving this support.

### 2. Meal Card Issuance

#### (1) Issuance Method and Amount

Provided as Hiroshima University co-op meal card.

(It will be given on the student ID card.)

Stipend Amount: 138,000yen equivalent per year

(\*The maximum daily usage is 700 yen. Therefore, depending on the frequency of use, it is possible to use more than the annual amount.)

#### (2) Meal Card Availability Period

From October 2026 to September 2027 (\*Uniformly available from October, 2026.)

#### (3) Number of Recipients

15 recipients

#### (2) Recommendation Letter from Supervisor (signature or seal required)

Note: If applicant without transcripts should be included a statement of academic performance on the recommendation letter. Also, if applicant has any peer-reviewed publications, please be sure to state so.

### 4. Application Period

Between June 29 (Mon.) and July 17 (Fri.), 2026

(Applications submitted after the last day of application are invalid.)

## 5. How to Apply

- (1) Application forms must be submitted via FORMS during the application period stated above.
- (2) Submit the recommendation letter from the supervisor to the Support Office of each school/graduate school by the application deadline, July 17, 2026.  
Once submitted, your documents will not be returned.

## 6. Selection

- (1) Selection will be made based on the 'Hiroshima University International Student Support Fund: Student Support Selection Guidelines'
- (2) The results of the selection will be notified on the individual bulletin board of MOMIJI etc.in late August.
- (3) Selected applicants are required to submit the prescribed pledge as soon as possible.

## 7. Revocation of Support Decision

Even after the support has been approved, authorities hold the right to cancel the approval in the following cases:

- (1) If it is found that the selected applicant received the support through false application or fraudulent means.
- (2) If the selected applicant is found to no longer meet the requirements.
- (3) If the selected applicant's academic performance has declined or the applicant is deemed to be of poor conduct.

## 8. Precautions

- (1) Receiving this support does not prevent recipients from applying for other scholarships. However, if a recipient is selected to receive another scholarship and is not eligible to receive this support under the terms of that scholarship, the awarding of this support will, in principle, cease from the month in which payment of the other scholarship begins. Note that, the timing of the termination of this support may be determined on a case-by-case basis, depending on factors such as the timing of decisions regarding other scholarships.
- (2) About Halal Food  
Halal breakfast is not served at the Co-op on Higashi-Hiroshima campus. No Halal meals available at the Co-op on Kasumi and Higashi-Senda campuses. Please understand this in advance.
- (3) All recipients of this support are required to join the Hiroshima University Co-op without omission.
- (4) Meal cards provided under this support cannot be exchanged for cash by cancellation, refund, etc.
