Scholarships from Private Foundations

More than 30 kinds of scholarships are available for international students who have “Student” visa.

Recommendation by the University

The information of these scholarships will be provided at the support office of each school or Graduate School mainly 6 times a year. Application will be accepted at the support office.

Applicant qualification

Enrolled students with “Student” visa.

The conditions depend on the foundations. The detailed information must be confirmed at the Support Office of each School or Graduate School before applications.

Notes

- You cannot apply for more than one foundation at the same time.
- When the number of candidates are limited, they will be selected by inner university selection.
- You cannot apply for another scholarship while you are waiting for the result of current applying.
- You are requested to fill in application forms **by yourselves**.
