oHiroshima University Regulations Regarding Utilization of Campus Parking Areas

(April 1, 2004 Regulation No. 115)

Hiroshima University Regulations Regarding Utilization of Campus Parking Areas Purpose:

Article 1. These regulations prescribe matters necessary to the proper utilization and management, etc. of parking areas at Hiroshima University (hereafter, This University), based on stipulations in Article 28 of Hiroshima University Regulations (April 1, 2004 Regulation No. 1).

Administrator:

Article 2. The president shall be the administrator of the parking areas.

Utilization Methods:

- Article 3. Employees, university students, and persons with business, etc. at This University (hereafter, Employees, etc.) may utilize the parking areas at This University.
- (2) Employees, etc. who intend to utilize the parking areas at This University must receive permission through a predetermined procedure prescribed by This University. Compliance Rules:
- Article 4. On campus, drivers shall observe the campus traffic rules prescribed by This University and be mindful of safe driving.

Prohibited Acts:

- Article 5. Employees, etc. are prohibited from carrying out the following acts in the parking areas.
 - [1] Defacement or damage within the parking areas
 - [2] Hindering the parking of other vehicles
 - [3] Carrying out actions that harm the management of the parking areas Temporary Regulations:
- Article 6. When necessary due to a state of emergency or events, etc. at This University, temporary regulations may be implemented.

Responsibility for Handling Accidents, etc.:

- Article 7. When a traffic accident occurs in a campus parking area, etc., driver(s) shall assume all responsibility for handling matters incidental to the accident.
- (2) In the case set forth in the preceding paragraph, Employees, etc. shall immediately notify the relevant department, etc. of a brief outline of the accident, regardless of the severity of damage.

Indemnity of This University:

Article 8. This University shall assume no responsibility for theft, damage, etc. of a vehicle that occurs while a vehicle is parked.

Miscellaneous Provisions:

Article 9. In addition to the regulations prescribed here, matters necessary to the implementation of these Regulations shall be separately prescribed.

Supplementary Provisions
This regulation shall come into effect from April 1, 2004.
