Course registration procedures for Common Graduate Courses

Students who are enrolled in the following graduate schools are required to take at least one (1) credit from each of the course categories, "Sustainable Development Courses" and "Career Development and Data Literacy Courses".

- Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences (Master's Program and Professional Degree Program)
- Graduate School of Advanced Science and Engineering (Master's Program)
- Graduate School of Integrated Sciences for Life (Master's Program)
- Graduate School of Biomedical and Health Sciences (Master's Program)
- Graduate School of Innovation and Practice for Smart Society (Master's Program)

1. Course registration must be completed on "My MOMIJI" during the designated registration period.

2. The number of courses that can be registered in each semester (1st [Spring] and 2nd [Fall]) is one (1) for each of the categories, "Sustainable Development Courses" and "Career Development and Data Literacy Courses."
3. Each course sets an enrollment limit. Therefore, if the number of applicants exceeds the limit, students who can attend the course will be selected by computerized random selection during the adjustment period. Please note that, depending on the selection result, different restrictions apply during the Confirmation and Revision Period as shown below.

If your course registration is accepted after the selection	If a student is allowed to keep their place after the selection, they cannot change or cancel their registration without any special reason. If there is such a special reason for changing or canceling it, please contact the office below.
If your course registration is NOT accepted after the selection	Students can register for a different course. However, only courses where the random selection did not occur will be open for the second round of registration if they still have room for new registrations in their enrollment limit. Please note that course registration after the selection will be on a first-come-first-served basis.

4. Please check syllabi carefully before the course registration. You can check the course list on "View Syllabus" page of My MOMIJI by selecting "Common Graduate Courses (Master's Course)" in "School/Graduate School" field.

[Important Note]

Students who are enrolled in **graduate schools other than those listed above** are also allowed to take the Common Graduate Courses (Master's Course and Professional Degree Course). In this case, however, the credits earned from the courses will NOT be counted for graduation requirements.
