

## 6. Notes on the Test

### ○Notes on the Test

1. The test must be completed during the “test period”.

No tests are allowed after the period.

Tests can be taken 24 hours a day.

2. In the event of multiple attempts, the test will be regarded as an illegal attempt.

You will not be allowed to take the test in the future.

3. Please bring headphones or earphones if necessary, as the questions will be audio-based.

4. The test is considered over when the timer counts down to zero and “Finish Test” is pressed.

5. Check the following requirements for PC operating environment.

You cannot take the test on a tablet, smartphone, or mobile phone.

\*\*Although Windows/ Microsoft Edge and macOS/Google Chrome are not included in the System Requirements specified by the Educational Testing Service (ETS), we have confirmed that they work without any problems through the operation verification conducted by IIBC.

6. An Authorization Code is required to take the test. An Authorization Code will be sent to the email address you entered in your registration process. Please keep them in a safe place.

7. Please note that you may not be able to take the test due to routine or emergency maintenance.

### ○Response to interruptions and problems caused by problems, etc.

If your PC stops working, you can close your browser and take the exam. Please interrupt the test. Then, go to the site as you started the exam and enter the Authorization Code. When you log in, you can press the “Resume Test” button to cancel the test. The test can be resumed from where.

### ○Prohibited activity

1. Provide, transfer or resell the Authorization Code to a third party.
2. Shooting, recording, audio recording, photocopying, etc.
3. Leaking the test questions and making them public.
4. Taking the test illegally, such as receiving assistance in answering the questions during the test.
5. Send harmful programs, etc.
6. Acts contrary to laws and regulations, public order and morals
7. Any other act that hinders the operator or unfairly harms the rights of a third party.
