Term-end Examination for Liberal Arts Education Courses

We are sure that you are preparing well for the upcoming term-end examinations. Students must comply with the following rules and take the examinations with integrity and are expected to perform at their best.

< Cheating at Examination>

If you cheat on a term-end examination, your grade will be a D (Fail) in all liberal arts education courses in this semester (except for Introductory Seminars for First-Year Students). In addition, disciplinary sanctions will be executed according to the Hiroshima University Student Disciplinary Regulations.

<In-person Examination>

- Display your student ID card on your desk during the examination.
 If you do not have your student ID card with you, you will not be permitted to take the examination.
 In that case, you need to ask the Student Support Office of your department to issue the examination certificate.
- 2. If you are late for the examination by more than one-third of the examination duration, you will not be permitted to take the examination.
- 3. You are not permitted to leave the examination room at least until 30 minutes have elapsed since the start of the examination.
- 4. You are not permitted to take out examination papers (question sheets and answer sheets) from the examination room.
- 5. You must not disturb other students during the examination.

<Online Examination>

- 1. Make sure that no one is around you before the examination.
- 2. If you are late for the examination by more than one-third of the examination duration, you will not be permitted to take the examination.
- 3. You must not disturb other students during the examination.
- 4. After taking the examination, submit your answers following the proctor's instructions.
