Visiting monuments on peace

1. Introduction

Hiroshima University consider what the first president Morito advocated, "a single unified university, free and pursuinig peace" as the spirit of the foundation of the university. We raise "the spirit of desiring peace" as the primary principle, because the first president placed Hiroshima University as a cultural and spiritual center of Peace City Hiroshima after the atomic bombing.

Needless to say, studying peace needs to face the tragedy of wars and nurture the viewpoints of looking for disarmament including abolition of nuclear weapons. Other than that, in order to nurture rich humanity through considering peace continuously from various points of view such as "poverty", "hunger", "increased population", "environment", "education" and "culture", Hiroshima University assigns all students peace science subjects and to visit peace monuments (Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum, etc.) to write reports on that to consider peace through their own experiences.

We hope everyone admitted to Hiroshima University to think about what peace is through learning peace science subjects.

2. Reports on peace monuments visiting

(1) Making the report

You are supposed to write the report after visiting monuments (Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum, etc.)

After visiting peace monuments, compose an assay in around 500 words what you thought about peace.

The visiting report is an essential assignment. When you fail to submit the report, the credit will not be given.

- Download the report form "Momiji top(note 1) →learning support →liberal arts education → information of subjects → Peace Science Courses (hereinafter referred as (*))" (Word). After downloading, make your report in your PC.
- The page setup of the form (margin, etc.) and the fond size (10.5point) are not being changes.
- You can submit only one PDF file. When you have images, etc., paste them in your report.

To avoid your writing being suspected of dishonest acts, you are necessarily required to read the "Rules and Guidelines for Writing a Report" to write your report.

(2) The deadline of the report

Following is the schedule of the deadline.

The 2nd term course-->June 19th (prearranged) ~June 30th

The 3rd term course-->October 10th (prearranged) ~October 21st

The 4th term course-->December 10th (prearranged) ~December 21st

Night program course-->according to the direction of the teachers

(3) The way of submission of the report

- · Make the file PDF form
- Be sure to name the file "student number.pdf" (ex. In case of your number is B199999, the file name is "B199999.pdf").
- · Please look at the" (*) in Momiji Top" for the way to change from Word form to PDF form.
- · Submit from Peace Science Course of Bb9(note 2).
- · Please look at the " (*) in Momiji Top" for the flow from logging in Bb9 to the submission.

(4) Awards

For students who write excellent reports, we plan to commend them in the following fiscal year.

3. Precautions on visiting monuments.

- ① Basically students are supposed to visit monuments by themselves, without accompanied by teachers. Please pay attention to avoid accidents.
- ② <u>Use basically public transportation for transfer.</u> When you inevitably use vehicles (including bicycles), please be careful about following,
 - Be aware that when incidents or accidents occur, it will be under your responsibility as a member of transportation society.
 - Pay detailed attention to following transportation rules and prevention of accidents. The same can be said to fellow passengers.
 - It is desired to buy a voluntary insurance or student life umbrella insurance with accident insurance and others to protect yourself.
- ③ Confirm the contact information and places of the nearest medical facilities and police offices and etc., in case of incidents or accidents.
- ④ In case of incidents and accidents, make your own safety as a priority and be sure to contact to the following inquires.
- This visiting is one of the official assignment of Hiroshima University. Therefore this visiting is the subject to compensation of Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research (PAS). In case of getting injuries during the visiting or to-and-for, apply to the support room (student support counter) of the school to make necessary procedure. But the injuries during shopping, dropping and other cases out of rational way and means are not covered by the PAS. When breaking monuments, exhibits and other others' property, the claim to a liability insurance occurs. Liability Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research (LSR) will cover this compensation, but Hiroshima University does not take part in the LSR collectively. Therefore please pay attention to exhibits. As for the details of PAS and LSR, please look at "studentlife handbook" or "Momiji".

4. Others

- ① When you need some consideration on visiting because you are unable to "watch", "hear", "read and write" and "move" with your physical conditions, consult to the class teacher.

- ② According to the contents of your report, we might ask you to open your report in and outside of the university.
