

Safety Confirmation in Emergency Cases

at Hiroshima University

(Revised in Sept. 2018)

1. Purpose and significance of safety confirmation

In case of natural and other major disasters, safety confirmation is necessary in order to identify material and human damage of Hiroshima University members (students, academic and faculty members) and ensure quick recovery.

2. Method of safety confirmation

In case of major disasters (e.g. an earthquake magnitude 6 or stronger), safety confirmation will be conducted on the campus as follows:

① Safety Confirmation via the Emergency Contact System (general)

A safety confirmation email will be sent to everyone's personal HU email address (xxx@hiroshima-u.ac.jp) simultaneously.

Safety confirmation will be conducted in each department separately via telephone calls, emails, etc.

3. Safety confirmation drill

Safety confirmation drill for Hiroshima University members including new students are conducted at least twice a year.
