

- Student can submit a learning support application to the faculty or graduate school that student belongs to

Applying for learning support

- 1 Consultation: Accessibility Center
- 2 Preparation of learning support application: Accessibility Center
- 3 Submit the application: Faculty/Graduate school
 - reasonable accommodations (determined case by case)



Types of learning support available to students

- Support for classes
 - > sending a request for special treatment to teachers
 - note-taking support
 - assisted writing/typing
- Daily living on campus
 - mobility support and guidance on campus

Types of learning support available to students

- for teaching materials...
 - > translation into electronic data, braille
 - enlarged copy
- Captioning for the video
- Loaning out the resources
 - > wheelchair, ICT resources, etc.
