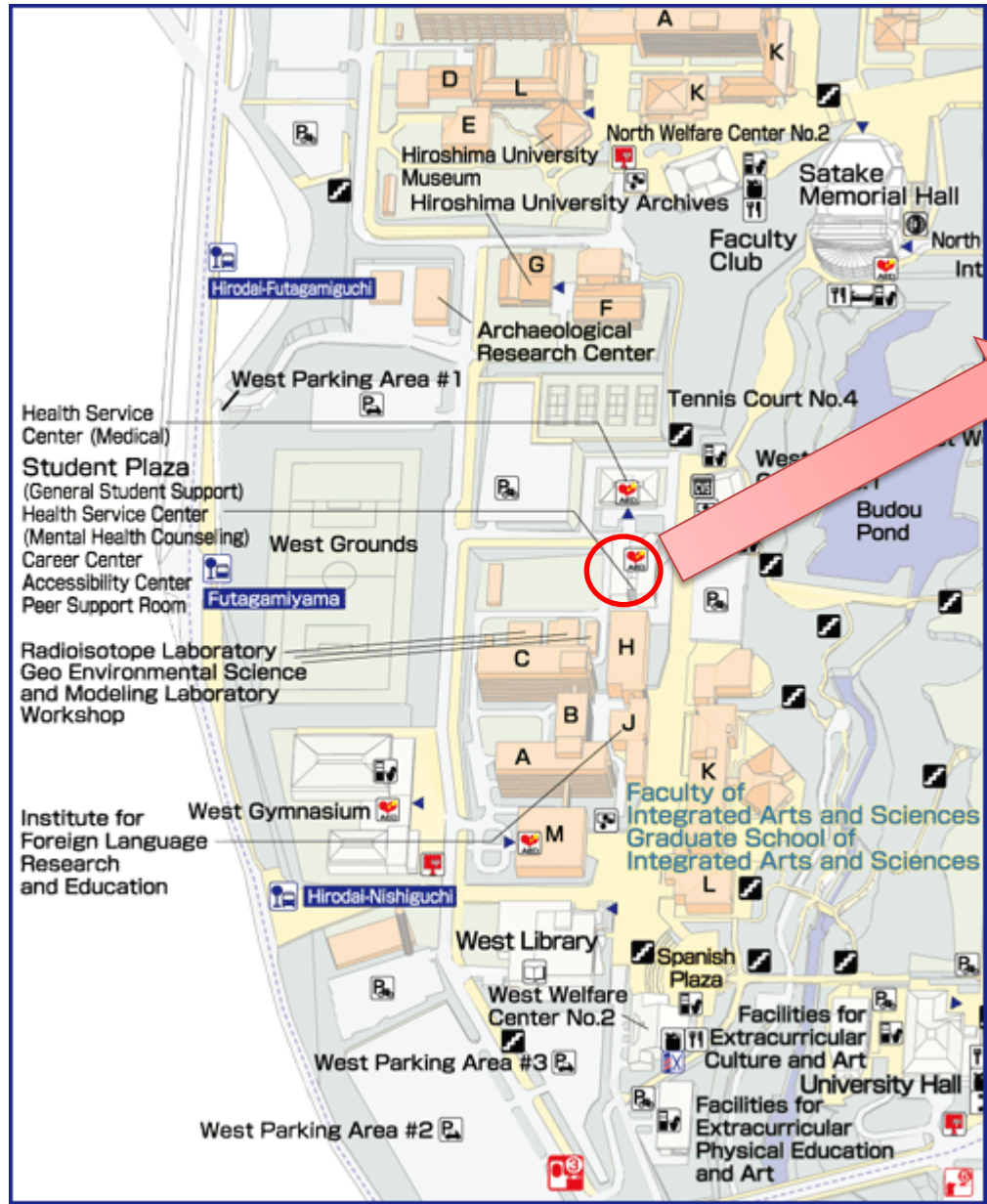

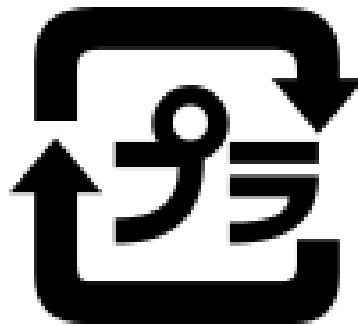

Basic Rules for Your Safety



- Never drink and drive.
- You cannot ride a motorcycle with an International Driver's License category B.
- Be sure to purchase a "Voluntary Insurance" before driving a car or motorcycle.

Including *Gentsuki*, bicycles with motors, or any two-wheeled vehicles

About Driver's License



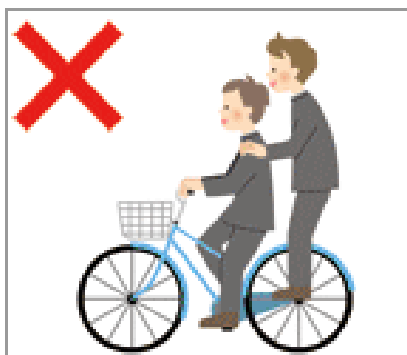
- **Never drive without a license!!**
【Please note that your international driver's license is not always valid.】
 - International driving permits are only valid for up to 1 year after entering Japan and the date of issue.
 - Permits obtained via Internet are not valid.
 - Only international driver's licenses from the member countries of the Geneva Convention are valid.
- **Get a Japanese license if you'll live in Japan more than a year and need to drive!**
- **Contact Hiroshima Prefecture Driver's License Center for more details.**

Riding a Bicycle?

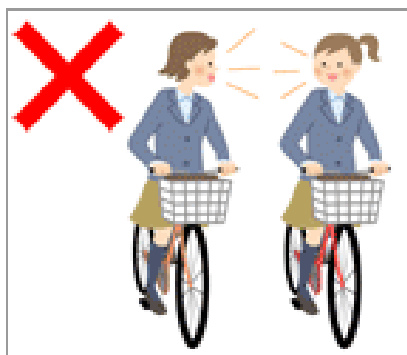
- Never use abandoned bicycle; or you could be charged with stealing.
- Get your bike registered for crime prevention at the store when you buy it.
- Update the registered information when you give your bike away or receive your friend's bike.
- Keep the bicycle law of Japan.
