Korean Language Class Outline (INTERMEDIATE)

COURSE TITLE : Korean Language Intermediate
COURSE DESCRIPTION
The purpose of this course is to enhance your Korean communication skills, with a particular focus on listening and speaking , two of the four language skills—speaking, listening, reading, and writing. Each class shares a common learning goal related to everyday life, enabling students to encounter and practice new situations, thereby building their speaking and listening skills. Additionally, this course will provide insights into Korean culture, and I will introduce aspects of it periodically.
RECOMMENDED READINGS
Seoul National University Korean 1
TEACHING METHODS
PPT In each class, we start with a review of the material covered in the previous lesson, using useful expressions. Following that, I teach the content aligned with the objectives of the class. We then work on exercises together, and finally, learners have the opportunity to actively participate in small group activities.
CLASS TOPICS
Class 1: Self-introductions Class 2: Who is this person? Class 3: Weather, Time and Dates Class 4: I caught a cold. Class 5: Talking on the phone. Class 6: Please go to Seoul Station. / What you say in a taxi.) Class 7: Try this on. / Words you need when shopping. Class 8: I want to go on a trip. / Telling what you want to do. Class 9: Can you come to my house? / Expressing the invitation. Class 10: Summary and speaking practice, comprehensive activity
