Course Descriptions: This credit-bearing beginner course is for native English speakers or students who use English as a medium language. The concept of the Chinese language will be made simple to arouse students' interest and help them build confidence. The course is designed to enable students to lay a good foundation. Effective teaching methods will be applied to help students, during their preliminary stage, acquire the basic knowledge of the structure of Chinese characters and Chinese grammar, providing them with a solid foundation particularly in the areas of Hanyu-Pinyin (Chinese Romanisation System), Chinese characters, vocabulary and fundamental sentence structure, and simple conversation.

Credits: 3 Lingnan Credits

Medium of Instruction: English and Putonghua

Platform: Zoom

Remarks: The online classes will be recorded. Students may follow the recorded classes in case they missed the real-time online classese.

Eligibility:

- Full-time students of our partner institutions
- A cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.5 (on a 4-point scale) or above
- For non-English native speaker, a TOEFL score of 213 (computer-based), 550 (paper-based) or 79 (internet-based), or an IELTS (Academic Module) score of 6.0 is required. We also accept a TOEIC score of 750* or a TOEFL ITP score of 550*.
 - *additional supporting letter on the student's English language proficiency i.e. the student is able to follow classes conducted in English from partner institutions is required.
- A recommendation letter by home institution (in English, from faculty or the International Office) with comments on why the student is recommended.
- Completed our online application by the deadline.


Student Nomination:
