⑫ コース概要/Course Outline このオンラインコースは日本、メキシコからの学生を対象とする。参加した学生は、それぞれの国のヘルスケア、看護（のみに限らず、健康や福祉、工学、教育、経済学などの分野でもよい）そして文化を学びながら、コース参加中に、事例についてグループでのディスカッションをし、国際看護師協会（International Council of Nurses：ICN）の災害看護コアコンピテンシーについて学ぶことを目的としている。 This online course will involve student’s participation from 2 countries (Mexico, Japan). Students will learn about healthcare, nursing (though not limited to nursing; fields such as health, welfare, engineering, education, and economics are also acceptable), and the culture of each country. During the course, students will engage in group work to discuss case studies of disaster. Through the group work students learn the International Council of Nurses (ICN) Framework of Disaster Nursing Competencies.

(1) 講義/ Lecture Plan
時期/Period : Around 2月/month 10日/day 頃 ~ 2月/month 28日/day 頃 内容/Details : Class 1 Orientation and ice break in the course (all teachers and TA) Class 2 Disaster Nursing in Japan (Mayumi Kako) Class 3 Disaster Nursing in Mexico (professor from UNAM) Class 4 ICN Framework of Disaster Nursing Competencies (Chie Teramoto) 時間数合計/Total hours : 8 時間/hours
(2) グループワーク/Group Work Plan
時期/Period : Around 2月/month 10日/day 頃 ~ 3月/month 13日/day 頃 内容/Details : In this class, students have the opportunity to share each other's culture, society, and disaster situations and prospect disaster nursing. In the 1st session, students, TA, and instructors introduce each other and identify current situation in disaster. In the 2-5 session, students discuss together and share health issues in disaster situations following by ICN Framework of Disaster Nursing Competencies' 8 domains: 1) Preparation and Planning, 2) Communication, 3) Incident Management, 4) Safety and Security, 5) Assessment, 6) Intervention, 7) Recovery, 8) Law and Ethics. Last sessions 2 session, the final presentation is prepared through a group discussion. 時間数合計/Total hours : 8 時間/hours
(3) グループ発表/Group Presentation Plan
時期/Period : Around 3月/month 16日/day 頃 ~ 3月/month 27日/day 頃 内容/Details : Students decide on a group presentation topic through discussion of an interesting issues among the topics covered in the class. Each group reviews and prepares presentations on thesis, articles, and policies on the topic. The final presentation by each group will be delivered with 20 minutes of presentation and 10 minutes of discussion. All Faculties and students freely engage in intensive and in-depth discussions. After the group presentation is over, the instructors and TA summarize the whole class. 時間数合計/Total hours : 3 時間/hours
