<p>⑫ コース概要／Outline of the course</p>	
<p>This course aims to orient students about the evolution of sustainable development agendas and introduce sustainable development goals. The focus will be on the first two goals i.e., no poverty and no hunger (Food security). These two goals target the persistent problems existing in developing countries, more specifically, the least developed countries mainly from Sub-Saharan Africa and South Asia. A concept of the vicious circle of poverty will be introduced and show how goals three (Good health and well-being) and four (Quality education) will be critical in breaking the vicious circle of poverty (poverty trap), thereby achieving the first two goals. Students are required to work in a multidisciplinary and multicultural group to present a case associated with either Goal one or Goal two and the solution/intervention that would be related to either Goal three good health and well-being and/or Goal four quality education.</p>
