⑪ コース概要/ Outline of the course

This program aims to enhance student awareness of international exchange through collaborative research and presentations with students of overseas universities, while enabling students to acquire the attributes of a talented global human resource. Moreover, it will allow students to learn how to work collaboratively and interact with overseas students using online systems. They will learn how to cooperatively create a vision for future development of sustainable tourism and gain first-hand knowledge of tourism in Japan and Vietnam.

(1) 講義 Plan of specialized lecture

時期/Period : 2022. 2 月/month 25 日/day ~ 2 月/month 26 日/day

内容/Details : (2 days)

Lectures will introduce students to the topic of the class and enable them to identify issues in sustainable tourism development

Day 1

Class 1 Orientation and ice break in the course (all teachers and TA) 2 hr

Class 2 Cultural Tourism in Asia (Jang) 2hr

Class 3 Changes in Travel Services in Vietnam Nowadays (Linh) 2h

Day 2

Class 4 Tourism in Japan (Funck) 2 hr

Class 5 Tourism in Vietnam (Hoang) 2 hr

Class 6 Groupwork introduction: the future of sustainable tourism (Qu, TA) 2 hr

(2) グループワーク Plan of group work

時期/Period : 2022. 2 月/month 27 日/day ~ 3 月/month 2 日/day

内容/Details : (3 days in March)

In this class, students have the opportunity to share each other's culture, society, and prospects for global/sustainable tourism. In the 1st session groupwork session, TAs will introduce the framework for group discussions and the presentation tools to be used. Students will learn step by step how to design a prospect for the future, taking in account political, economic, social, environmental and technological factors.

Day 3-5

Class 7-13 Groupworks (groupwork supported by TA) 14hr

(3) グループ発表 Plan of final group presentation

時期/Period : 2022. 3 月/month 3 日/day

内容/Details : (1 day)

Students choose one topic out of a suggested list of topics for their group presentation. Based on 30 students, a total of 6 groups of 5 students per group are organized. Each group reviews and prepares presentations based on articles, and policies on the topic. The final presentation by each group will be delivered with 15 minutes of presentation and 10 minutes of discussion. After the group presentation is over, the instructors and TA summarize the whole class.

Day 6

Class 14-15 Group presentations and Discussion (all teachers and TA), Conclusions (all teachers and TA) 4hr
