Course registration procedures for Common Graduate Courses

Students who are enrolled in the following graduate schools are required to take at least one (1) credit from each of the course categories, "Sustainable Development Courses" and "Career Development and Data Literacy Courses".

- Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences (Doctoral Program)
- Graduate School of Advanced Science and Engineering (Doctoral Program)
- Graduate School of Integrated Sciences for Life (Doctoral Program)
- Graduate School of Biomedical and Health Sciences (Doctoral Program)
- Graduate School of Innovation and Practice for Smart Society (Doctoral Program)

1. Course registration must be completed on "My MOMIJI" during the designated registration period.

2. The number of courses that can be registered in each semester (1st [Spring] and 2nd [Fall]) is one (1) for each of the categories, "Sustainable Development Courses" and "Career Development and Data Literacy Courses" (please note that this rule does not apply to "Long-term internship").

3. Each course sets an enrollment limit. Therefore, if the number of applicants exceeds the limit, students who can attend the course will be selected by computerized random selection during the adjustment period. Please note that, depending on the selection result, different restrictions apply during the Confirmation and Revision Period as shown below.

If your course registration is accepted after the selection	If a student is allowed to keep their place after the selection, they cannot change or cancel their registration without any special reason. If there is such a special reason for changing or canceling it, please contact the office below.
If your course registration is NOT accepted after the selection	Students can register for a different course. However, only courses where the random selection did not occur will be open for the second round of registration if they still have room for new registrations in their enrollment limit. Please note that course registration after the selection will be on a first-come-first-served basis.

4. Please check syllabi carefully before the course registration as some courses involve a trip for a certain period. You can check the course list on "View Syllabus" page of My MOMIJI by selecting "Common Graduate Courses (Doctoral Course)" in "School/Graduate School" field.

5. On-demand classes are offered to students who have difficulty in attending school during regular hours. For more information, please check the following website.
