

Hiroshima University Basic Policy regarding a Total Ban on Smoking on its Campuses

Hiroshima University (the “University”) plans to implement a total ban on smoking on its campuses from January 1, 2020, aiming to strengthen passive smoking prevention measures and send non-smoking students out into society. (Refer to the Hiroshima University No-smoking Declaration issued on January 25, 2019.)

A total ban on smoking shall be implemented according to the following basic policy. Hiroshima University Passive Smoking Prevention Measures (approved by the President on February 2011) will be abolished.

(Promotion of the Roadmap)

1. According to the Roadmap toward a Total Ban on Smoking on its Campuses (created on January 25, 2019), the University promotes non-smoking initiatives, such as non-smoking education, non-smoking consultation and support, and the announcement of non-smoking campuses to people inside and outside the University, in a systematic and comprehensive manner on a university-wide basis.

(Target People)

2. Target people who are banned from smoking are the members of the University (students, faculty members, etc.) and those from outside the University who enter the premises of the University. Smoking to be banned includes that with electronic and heated cigarettes.

(Target Area)

3. Target areas where smoking is banned include the premises of the University (including the inside of buildings and cars) and part of the areas and roads around the University designated separately.

Even in areas other than non-smoking areas, it is required to refrain from smoking on roads and sidewalks and in front of stores around the University, so that smoking will not annoy residents living in the vicinity of the University. Thus, due consideration should be given to the prevention of passive smoking.


(Implementation of a Tour of Inspection)

4. As countermeasures against smoking in non-smoking areas and cigarette butt littering, Safety

and Health Management Committee members shall regularly make a tour of inspection.


(Smoking on the Job)

5. In terms of the prevention of undesired passive smoking and the obligation to concentrate on their duties, faculty members are required to refrain from smoking on the job regardless of inside or outside the premises of the University.




Roads and Other Areas Designated Separately around the University
